- ❖ Diarrhea.
- ❖ Difficult or rapid breathing.
- ❖ Fever.
- ❖ Headache, earache, stiff neck.
- ❖ Lethargy.
- ❖ Persistent-crying or irritability.
- ❖ Pink eye.
- ❖ Severe cough.
- ❖ Signs of a contagious disease.
- ❖ Unidentified rash.
- ❖ Vomiting.
- ❖ Yellowish skin or eyes.
